#### Location

#### Range

The location of the range will be provided to you during the class.

#### Food and Drinks

You may bring food and drinks to the classroom portion of the course.

#### Weapons and Ammunition

Please bring the handgun you plan on carrying for self-defense and 100 rounds of the correct factory ammunition. **Your firearm and ammunition will not be allowed in the classroom.** Leave your handgun and ammunition locked in the trunk of your vehicle. We will inspect them at the range prior to beginning the range portion of the course to make sure they are safe to use.

The handgun you bring to the course must be safe to fire. If you are unsure if your firearm is safe to use for this course have it checked by a gunsmith. Factory ammunition only; reloads will not be allowed for this course.

#### Handgun Rental

If you do not have a firearm you may rent one for the class for a \$20 fee. We have six handguns available for rental and renters will be provided a holster for rental handguns. We will buy the ammo for rented handguns and pass the cost on to you. The ammo cost varies due to ammo shortages and increasing costs. If you need to rent a handgun please **notify us immediately** so we can reserve one for you. Otherwise you will not be able to complete the course.

## **Equipment**

You will need to bring the following equipment for the Basic Protection in the Home course:

- Note paper
- Writing utensil
- Eye protection
- Ear protection
- Safe Handgun (you will use for self-defense. A .38 cal., 9mm, .357, or .40 cal. Semi-Auto pistol or revolver are preferred) \* No sharing of handguns.
- Two magazines or two speed loaders for revolver users.
- Holster for your weapon
- Belt for your holster
- Ball cap
- 100 rounds of the correct factory ammunition for your firearm.
- Foul weather gear (we will shoot in all weather)

## **Lunch**

A lunch break of one hour will be provided between the classroom and range portion of the course.

## **Woman**

If you are pregnant you must provide written permission from your doctor to attend this course. Please do not wear low-cut shirts as there is potential that hot ammunition casings to go down such a shirt.

## **Medications**

If you take any medications please continue to take them the day of the course.

## **Cancellations**

All cancellations must be received at least seven days before the start of the course. After that time, registration refunds are subject to a \$50 cancellation fee. You may also switch to another class, if scheduled without a cancellation fee. Cancellation requests must be received by:
